Reddy's Laboratories, GVK, Aurobindo, Mylan, Suven Life sciences, Hetero Pharma, Piramel, Sun Pharma, Sanofi, Deawong, Newheit, Natco Pharma, Acipher, Novartis etc. Placement drivers are conducted frequently and not even single student is unemployed. We have 100% placements.

About Centre for Nanoscience and Technology:

Centre for Nano Science and Technology, a constituent unit of IST was established in 2007 with main focus on teaching and research in the field of Nano Technology. The centre is uniquely placed in the university's landscape offering following PG courses: M.Sc, M.Tech, M.S Research and Ph.D. in Nanotechnology. The centre is actively undertaking research work in the areas of Nano materials and composites, Energy, Electronic, Bio-medical & Environmental applications.
